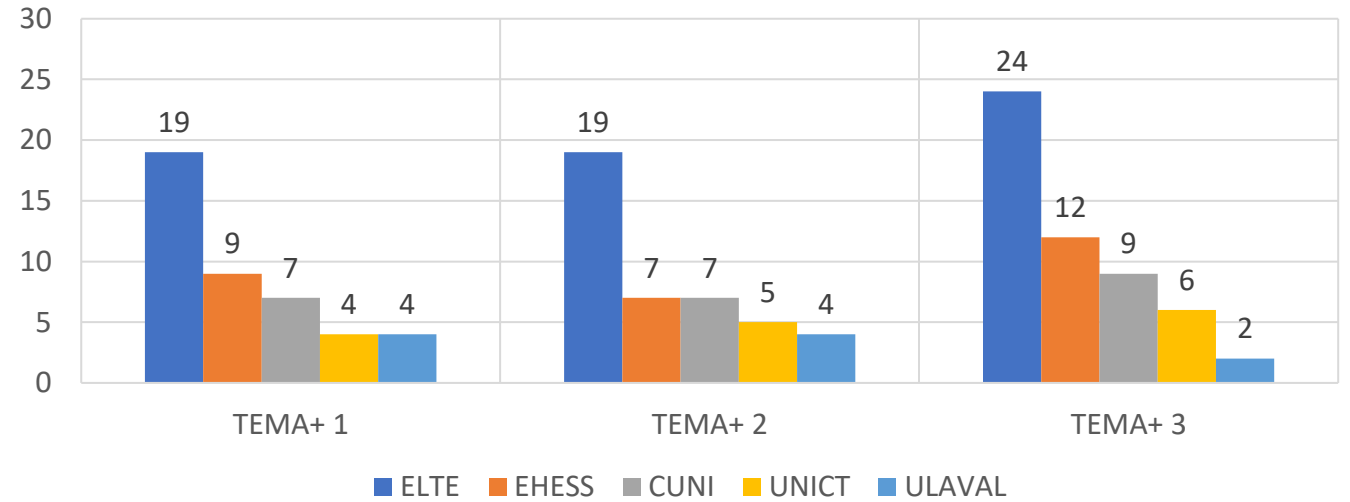


TEMA+ Student' Age
